

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINGER
COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDING - WINGER, MN**

The public information meeting was presented by Brian Hiles – Engineer from Ulteig. Hiles addressed the Plan for Sanitary Sewer System and provided a map of the sewer system of what will need to be replaced. Two major parts that will be looked at will be the Collection System and Treatment Ponds. The entire Collection System was televised in 2017/2018 and the reports are showing leaks, root penetration, sags, and damaged pipes. Some spots were really bad that the camera wasn't able to go through the pipes. Proposed project is open trench replacements and Replace both lift stations. It looks like 75% of the Collection System in need of replacement. Estimated Collection System Replacement cost is \$1,967,500 and the Treatment Pond Upgrades would be \$727,900. Total Project Cost \$2,695,400 with a Grant of \$1,258,700.00 and a Loan \$1,436,700. Projected sewer fee would be around \$50 per month. There will be minimal disruption to the residents if the project gets going. Treatment Ponds will be replaced one at a time; it will work with no disruption to the residence. Replacing one Treatment Pond and using the other during the construction phase. As far as moving the project forward; discussion will take place at the next Council Meeting in February.
